
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ACCREDITATION

SCHOOL OVERVIEW





IGCSE

Students in Grade 9 and 10 pursue the International General Certificate of Secondary Education, which is a broad based and challenging curriculum for 14-16 year olds. The IGCSE syllabus places strong emphasis on application based learning. In Grade 9, students are required to choose certain mandatory subjects, whereas in Grade 10, they must enroll in a minimum of seven subjects. The grading is on an eight-point scale (A* to G) and grades A to E are equivalent to O Level Grades A to E. In addition to their IGCSE studies, the students are encouraged to undertake career counseling and attend summer courses to explore their interests further.
